COVID-19 PREPARE. MAKE PLANS.

It's important to have an emergency plan in the event you or a loved one contracts COVID-19.

This includes coordinating care options for family pets.



- Designate a trusted pet caregiver: family, friend, neighbor, or colleague.
- Record important pet information (feeding plan, medical information, etc.).
- If your pet takes medication, ask your veterinarian for an extra supply.
- Have a carrier, food, extra litter, and other essential supplies on hand.
- Check your area for potential boarding options in the event it's neccessary.
- Keep cat's collar, identification, harness, and Go Bag readily accessible.

IF YOU CONTRACT COVID-19:

- 1. Have another member of your household care for your pet.
- 2. Restrict contact with your pets and wash your hands often.
- 3. Wash pet bedding, harnesses, collars, dishes, and toys often.

The CDC reports there is no current evidence that pets can spread the virus that causes COVID-19 to humans.
